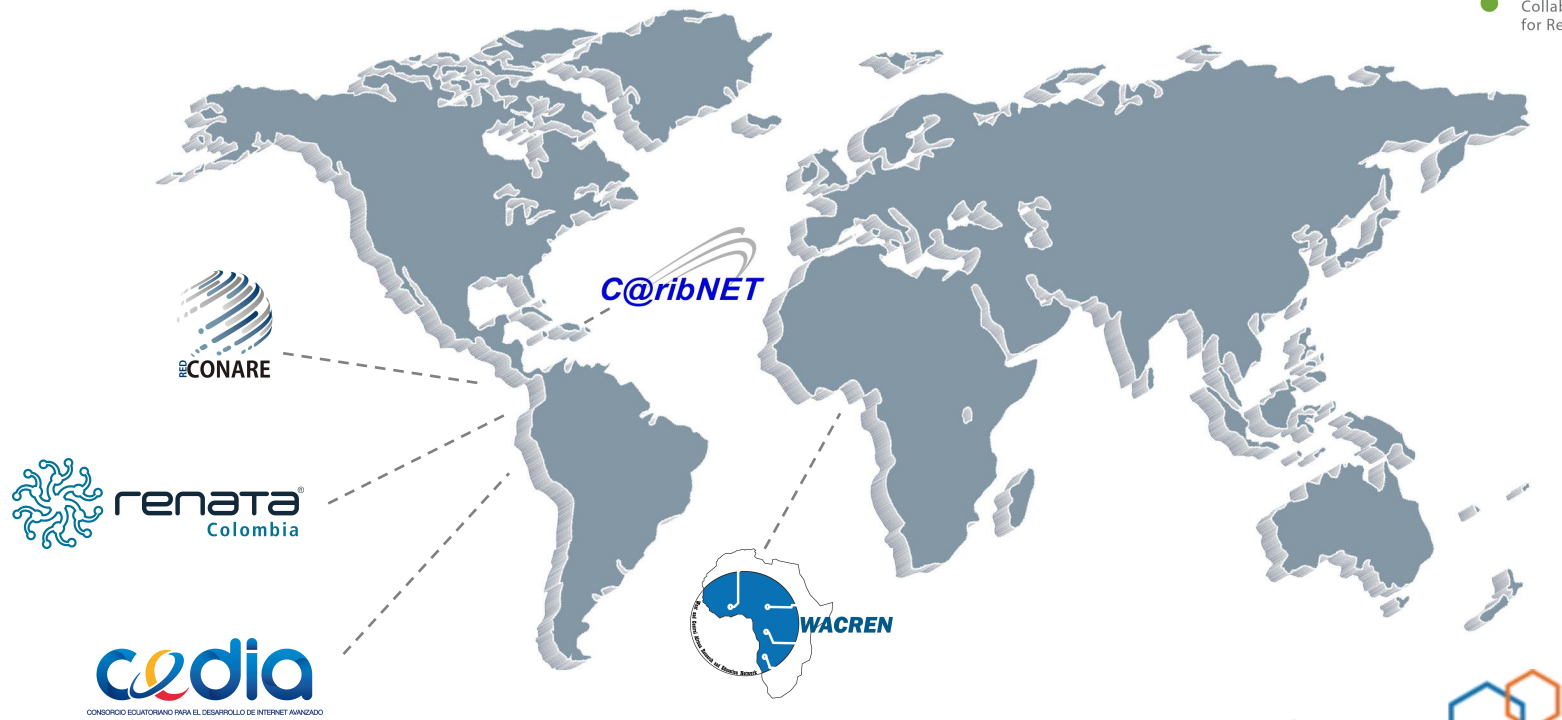
What's Colaboratorio?

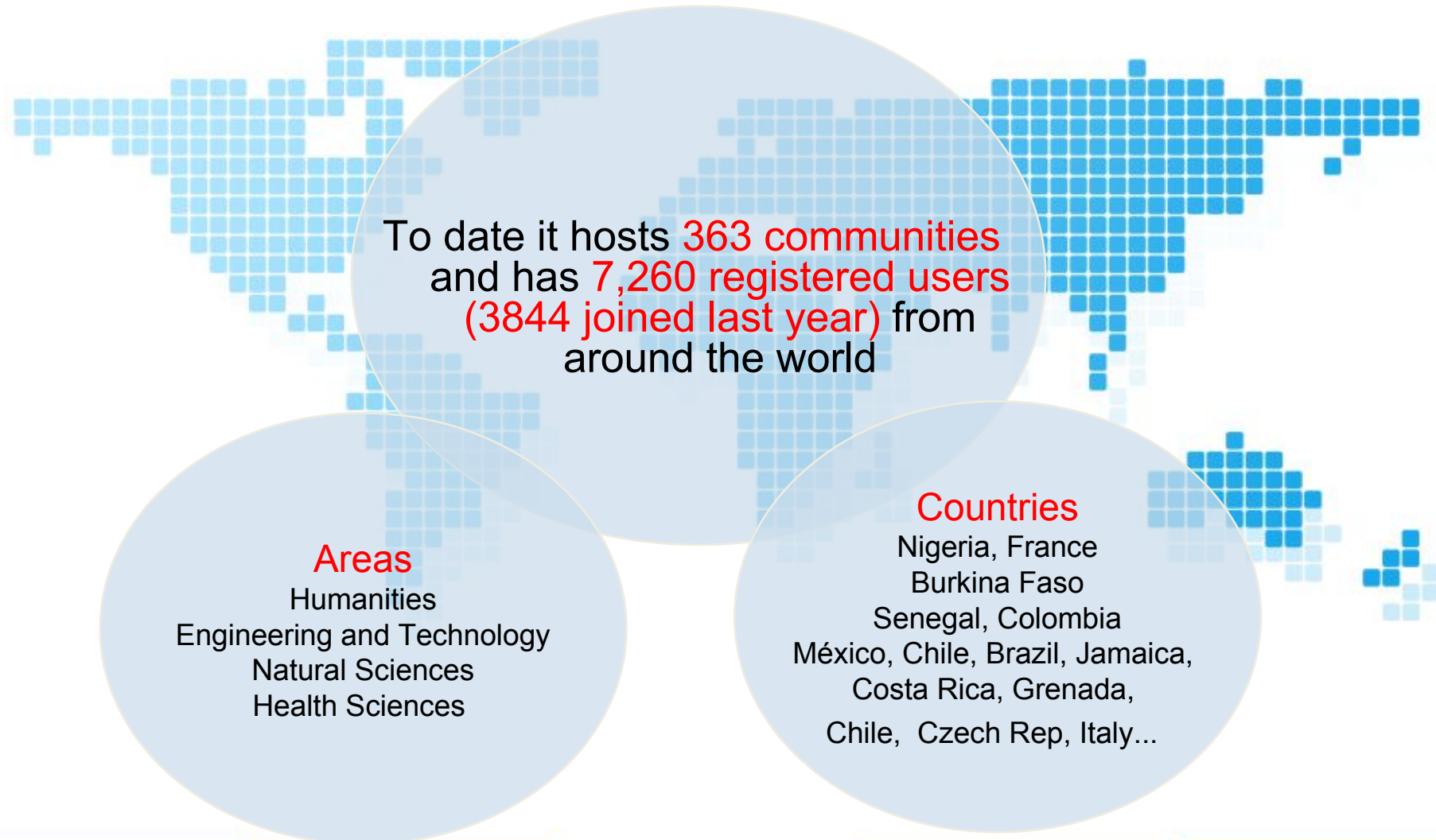

What can we do on Colaboratorio?



eNVIO: Large files transfer

- Complete the fields of the form, choose the file to be sent and write the recipient email (you have up to 10GB for every transfer).
- Define the period of time in which the material will be available for download; after 20 days the system will delete your files automatically.
- eNVIO allows you to upload files with extensions doc, xls, pdf, docx, odt, xlsx, mov, rar and zip. If you want to send more than one file or your document has a different extension, compress them and use one of the two last formats to upload them.
- Only the people you have shared the file with, will receive an email with a link to download it.

The Horizon Prize for breaking the optical transmission barriers is a €500 000 challenge prize. It will be awarded to a solution that maximises the fibre capacity per channel, spectrum range and/or spectral efficiency and reach. It should also be energy efficient, economically viable, and easy to install and deploy. The solution should have a strong potential to be adopted in future generations of optical-system products.

- Horizon Prize - Food Scanner** (2016-03-09)
Electrical engineering, electronic engineering and information engineering - Health sciences
This Horizon 2020 Inducement Prize will thus be awarded to the most significant development towards a portable solution that, alone or in combination with other devices (e.g. smartphones), will enable the European citizens to detect nutrition facts and allergens in several types of food in a precise, efficient and timely manner, using a non-invasive and non-destructive approach, with the goal to help them make optimal informed choices and to improve their health and well-being.
